2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.

**G PIREAS01:** Nominated students receive by e-mail their Application Form and Learning Agreement that they have to complete within the deadline above. Once completed, they receive an acceptance letter by e-mail within a max. of 6 weeks. Changes To Original Learning Agreement can only be made by students in the 2 weeks after the start of classes. Must respect this deadline.

**LT KAUNAS01:** Nominated students receive by e-mail their Application Form and Learning Agreement that they have to complete within the deadline above. Once completed, they receive an acceptance letter by e-mail within a max. of 6 weeks. Changes To Original Learning Agreement can only be made by students in the 2 weeks after the start of classes. Must respect this deadline.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

#### 4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the interinstitutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
