The **application form** is completed by the Incoming Student, only after the official nomination of the Sending HEI.



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2. **Political ID card or passport** (Please send all documents together and not one by one in different emails in a pdf file. Pictures will not be accepted).

3. European Health Insurance Card

The European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is issued free of charge to anyone who is insured by or covered by a statutory social security scheme of the EEA countries.

4. Language Certificate

The main language of instruction University of Piraeus is Greek with the exception of the Departments which offer courses mainly in English.

In those departments of the University of Piraeus that do not offer courses in English, there are special arrangements for Erasmus+ students, such as specialized projects and meetings/lectures with professors in English, assignments etc, as the case may be.

The University of Piraeus requires good knowledge -Level B2- of English language (or Greek, depending on the field of study) so that students are able to communicate and function within an academic context.

Nominated students must have a B2 Level in English.

Students will need to provide official language certificates of Level B2 for English.

Please note that the official language certificates accepted are IELTS, IGCSE, TOEFL, CAE Cambridge (scores 160–179 and above=Level B2).
